Introduction to the Team Cuisine Smart App

The Smart Pressure Cooker can be paired with your mobile device and controlled through the Team Cuisine Smart App, enabling you to cook, adjust and monitor the progress of your meals on the go, browse recipes, and save your favourites.

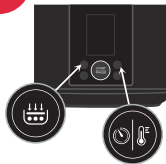
Pair with “Auto Scan”

1



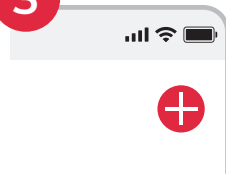
Turn on Smart Pressure Cooker.

2



Press and hold the **PRESSURE LEVEL** button and the **TIME / TEMP** button simultaneously for 5 seconds until WiFi indicator begins to blink and you hear a beep.

Open the Team Cuisine Smart App and tap “+” in the top right corner of the screen.

Note: Ensure the WiFi and Bluetooth of your mobile device are enabled.

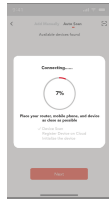
Select the **Auto Scan** tab. It will automatically detect the Smart Pressure Cooker and then tap next.

5



Select the same WiFi network of your mobile device and enter the password and tap next.

6



The Smart Pressure Cooker and the app will now begin the pairing process.

7



After successfully configuring the device, tap **Done** to finish the pairing.

Pair with “Add Manually”

ADD MANUALLY AUTO SCAN



Alternatively, the Smart Pressure Cooker can be paired using the Add Manually option on the app. Tap the “+” button on the top right corner and select the Add Manually tab. Find and select the Smart Pressure Cooker and then follow the instructions on the screen.

Note:

> Always select 2.4GHz WiFi network when there is an option.

> The default pairing setting is EZ mode. Under EZ mode, long press again the WiFi button for 3 seconds can switch to AP mode and the WiFi indicator will begin to blink slowly. For AP mode pairing, please follow the instructions on your mobile device screen.
